Time and Clearance Requirements for Snow Removal

Snow must be cleared from residential properties by six (6) hours after a snowfall. Residents must clear their sidewalk completely, up to 42 inches. (Somerville Code of Ordinances, Section 12-8)

Icy Sidewalks

All ice-covered walks must be covered by sand or another covering that gives good traction (like clay- or sand-based kitty litter). The Department of Public Works provides sand at key locations through out the City.
